Everyone must be shown how to use them properly before using them, and they will not be available for use on large flat faces or large irregular shaped rocks as they are meant for doing cabochon style stones and the flexible surface does not react well to other applications. A trophy presentation ceremony was held on Saturday evening where Western Suburbs Lapidary Club of NSW was presented with the Ray Powell Trophy for the Champion Club and other individual trophies were awarded. The trophies were hand painted Tasmanian scenes on pieces of Tasmanian Slate, all painted by Sam Caberica. This was followed by an auction which raised money for a local charity and then some wine and cheese tasting. It was a great night.

On Monday at 12 noon the Competition area was closed off to allow entries to be repackaged and ready for collection at 3pm which was after the GEMBOREE closed to the public.

At this point I would like to give my sincere thanks to the volunteers from the mainland who willingly stepped up to assist me and Sam with all the work associated with setting up and repackaging the competition entries ready for collection by the competitor.

The mailing back of the postal entries has been left in Sam's capable hands.
