## ***“C” is for Chrysoprase***

Chrysoprase was called the stone of Venus, and is the rarest and most valuable rich apple-green gemstone in the chalcedony family. It was often mistaken for emerald by ancient jewellers. Unlike emeralds, which owe their colour to the presence of chromium, the bright spring green of Chrysoprase is the result of trace amounts of nickel. Chrysoprase is one of the birthstones for May.

Poland had the most prominent Chrysoprase mine before it was completely depleted in the 14<sup>th</sup> century. Today most of the world's Chrysoprase comes from Western Australia, Germany, Russia, Zimbabwe, South Africa, Indonesia, India, Kazakhstan, Brazil, and the States of Arizona, California and Oregon in the USA.

However, the best quality Chrysoprase came from the mine at Marlborough in Queensland. It was discovered there in the early 1900s, and from the 1960s it was considered to produce the best in the world because of its high nickel content, which combined with the local soil constituents gives a deep green colour with exceptional translucency. It also has a much lower incidence of colour fading than is common in material from other areas. Top grade Chrysoprase with a high degree of translucency is very sort after in china and other Asian countries, where it is extremely expensive.

Most of the Chrysoprase from the Marlborough mine finished up in China, where the best quality was often used as a jade substitute. Unfortunately, there has been no mining of Chrysoprase at the Marlborough mine since 2005.

Chrysoprase is credited with a wide range of healing and mental wellness attributes as well as having a spiritual protection ability.

It is also claimed to have a strong ability to balance the hormones; treat reproductive organs and repair fertility problems. [*It has been suggested that I should buy some large high quality pieces !!*]

**The 2020 GEMBOREE has been cancelled as of 14th March 2020.**

Recent Federal Government announcements relating to the Covid 19 pandemic and a recommendation to avoid gatherings of 500 or more people, made the final decision unavoidable.

Because the GEMBOREE Competition is divided into two parts – “Entries Judged Before the Show” and “Entries Judged at the Show”, a decision also had to be made about the status of the Competition.

The “Entries Judged Before the Show” have already been judged, given placings and will be awarded medallions and trophies. Photographs will be taken of the entries in each Section that were awarded a medallion, and then posted on the AFLACA website. Some or all of these photographs could also be displayed on the VGCA website and in the Pointer. All entries, medallions and trophies will be returned to the entrants either by hand or by post over the coming weeks.

The “Entries Judged at the Show” can no longer be part of the official competition. Because of the costs associated with returning the nominal entry fee of \$5, no entry fees will be returned unless specifically requested by the entrant.
