April 2023 G&I News Rocks and Minerals at DAYBORO QLD

Occurrence of green, jade-like, variscite veins in sedimentary rocks.

VARISCITE.

DESCRIPTION: Compact, massive variety, which typically consists largely of variscite but commonly includes other minerals and/or rock materials. Properties of variscite follow:

Colours - off-white, buff, gray, yellow, green, brown, pink with several shades of green with yellow-green to bluish green the most common, with the colours of individual nodules ranging from virtually one solid colour to all sorts of arrangements of diverse hues -- e.g., "eyes," weblike patterns, and swirls. **H.** $3\frac{1}{2}$ $-4\frac{1}{2}$ **S.G.** 2.3 - 2.6 Light transmission -

translucent to opaque.

Luster - dull, pearly or waxy

OTHER NAMES: Australian jade - misnomer for variscite from the vicinity of Dayboro. southeastern Queensland, Australia.

The Dayboro Mineral Occurrence is a copper mine, which is located just off the Burpengary Creek in southeast Queensland a distance of 36km north-northwest from Brisbane. This is about 177m above sea level. The nearest populated place is the village of Dayboro which is 3.7km away with a population of around 860. The nearest sealed road to Dayboro Mineral Occurrence is the Dayboro Rd (1.74km away).

Face Book mentions: Members of the Redcliffe Gem Club, went fossicking along Laceys Creek Rd at Dayboro and found some jasper and petrified wood.
