Conchoidal – most common – sea shell markings –

quartz, beryl, glass, corundum,

obsidian

Fibrous - nephrite, chrysotile

Even/uneven – prehnite, rhodonite

Hackly - jadeite, copper-shape, irregular





#### **CLEAVAGE:**

The tendency of a mineral crystal to split along certain planes which are parallel to actual or possible crystal faces, yielding more or less smooth, flat surfaces. Appearance – flat shining planes or fine steps.

One Plane- Basal or pinacoidal cleavage - Mica, topaz(faceting)

Two planes - Prismatic cleavage - feldspars





Three planes - Galena (cubic), Calcite (rhombohedral)

Four planes - Diamond, Fluorite (octahedral)







Six planes - Dodecahedral cleavage — Sphalerite


