


Some Mineralogy and Gemmology Basics Continued Geology - Rock Types


The Rock Cycle

Most rocks were once other rocks.

The earth is a dynamic state with constant change, though this is not too obvious in Australia, with the odd flood and dust storm.







The solid Layer we live on CRUST and averages around 35km thick, whilst the molten Layer below is called the MANTIF 35-2900km. much further in we have the CORE

(outer core molten inner core solid) 2900-6370Km.

WHAT IS A ROCK?

A rock is a naturally occurring aggregate of minerals and/or other rock fragments.

ROCK FORMING MINERALS – With more than 5000 known minerals, there is only about 20 that are very common, and only 9 of these constitute 95% of the crust. These 9 minerals are all silicates, and are also called the **rock forming minerals**.

The following are the common rock forming minerals. These are of great importance being the primary minerals that make up the different types of rocks found in the Farth's crust.

FELDSPAR



potassium feldspar KAlSi₃O₈ - potassium (chemical symbol K) and are often a pink-ish colour



plagioclase feldspar - NaAlSi₃O₈ sodium (chemical symbol Na) and/or CaAlSi₂O₈ calcium (chemical symbol Ca) instead of potassium


