Some Mineralogy and Gemmology Basics Continued Geology - Rock Types

All rocks are divided into 3 broad classifications, **IGNEOUS**, **SEDAMENTARY & MET-AMORPHIC** within each are various divisions.

IGNEOUS:

This rock was once molten. The mobile magma can do 2 things;

Force its way into existing rocks beneath the earth's surface or be pushed up to the surface.

The former is called **INTRUSIVE** or **PLUTONIC** whilst the latter is called **EXTRUSIVE** or **VOLCANIC**.

INTRUSIVE rocks cool slowly and so allow the formation of large crystals – **COARSE GRAINED**.

EXTRUSIVE rocks cool quickly and hence a lack of obvious crystals – **FINE GRAINED** – Obsidian is extrusive.

This observation is called **TEXTURE**.


----- But wait there is more ------

Intrusive and extrusive rocks are classified based on their silica (SiO₂) content.


CHEMICAL COMPOSITION – 2 broad classifications – **FELSIC (ACIDIC)** rich in quartz and **MAFIC (BASIC)** rich in magnesium/ iron minerals.

Ultramafic and **mafic** rocks have lower SiO_2 tend to be relatively dark in colour (e.g., basalt) ~50% SiO_2 , lots of Mg, Fe, and Ca, major minerals are olivine, pyroxene, and plagioclase

Felsic, or **silicic**, rocks have higher SiO_2 contents and tend to be lighter in colour (e.g., granite). >65% SiO_2 , more Al, Na, K, major minerals are feldspars, quartz, micas

GRANITE is a common intrusive rock; a coarse grained variety is called **PEGMATITE**. Here large crystals of quartz, Topaz, Beryl, Spodumene, Tourmaline may occur. FINE GRAIN: RHYOLITE, TRACHYTE, PORPHYRY

Other gems of igneous origin are Diamond, Zircon, Peridot, Sapphire and spinel in Australia and Thailand.



- 3. Competitors should be aware of, or check their eligibility to enter a Novice or Intermediate Division either by: -
- Reading Section B4 of the manual (pages 6 & 7) relating to Competition Divisions, or by
- checking the updated results list on the AFLACA website (http://aflaca.org.au)


