

GAA Certificate in Opal Studies—Editor's Views on the Opal Course

In late January I received an email from GAA NSW re a new online course on Opal that had just been officially launched. After thinking about it for a few days and discussing it with the Boss (wife), I decided to try the course. You can do the course at your own pace as you have six months to complete it. I started it on the 28 January and completed it on the 20 February. I found it interesting and informative.

I knew a bit about opal or so I thought, and that this would just be reinforcement of what I knew. In some respects, that's what happened. One of the main things with the course was the new international opal classification and description system that has been released by CIBJO (the World Jewellery Confederation) and developed in consultation with the GAA and Australian opal industry. This is a big expansion on the original Australian system developed in 1997.

The course is quite comprehensive dealing with all forms of Opal from around the world. The course touches on the ethical sourcing, trading, mining, formation of opal, opalised fossils, classification of, handling, storage and value factors.

I found that the detailed pictures and videos help greatly to understand the new definitions system and value factors affecting the pricing and value of world opal.

My only criticisms would be that it would be nice to have access to the information supplied on line beyond the 12-month period. It would have been good also to have more information on the mining of Queensland opal as it covers a large area of the state, for example the levels at which Yowah Nut were formed/found?

Although the course may not suit everyone, I would recommend it to anyone wanting to know more about the opal they are selling and or playing with. You can find out more at the GAA site https://www.gem.org.au/courses/opal-studies/

GEMKHANA 2025 – COMPETITION SCHEDULE AND CONDITIONS GENERAL CONDITIONS



- 1. This is a Level 3 Competition and will be judged in accordance with the rules and definitions of the *Competitor & Judging Manual for Lapidary and Allied Competitions Issue no. 8 April 2015.* (referred to in this Schedule as the Manual), unless otherwise stated in this Schedule.
- 2. All competitors are advised to familiarise themselves with all the "Conditions for Competitors" in the Manual (particularly pages 5 to 13)
- 3. Competitors should be aware of, or check their eligibility to enter a Novice or Intermediate Division either by: -
- Reading Section B4 of the manual (pages 6 & 7) relating to Competition Divisions, or by checking the updated results list on the AFLACA website (http://aflaca.org.au)
- 4. Enquiries, correspondence and ALL POSTAL ENTRIES relating to this Competition should be directed to:

- **5.** Maximum number of entries allowed is two (2) per person per section except for Showcase Sections where only one entry per person is allowed.
- **6.** It is the Competitor's responsibility to ensure that their entries are entered in the correct section and that the sections are correctly marked on the Entry Form. If in doubt ring the Competition Committee.

However, the Competition Committee may transfer an entry into another section if they are of the opinion that it has obviously been enter in the incorrect section.

- 7. Entry Fees: \$1.00 per entry for the first 10 entries, thereafter free.

- **8.** All entries not being collected in person at the GEMKHANA must be accompanied by the **cost of return** post or **pre-paid post bag** included with the entry form (see Page 13).

10. Competitors and exhibitors are responsible for the insurance of their entries or exhibits while in transit, and whilst in the possession of the GEMKHANA 2025 Committee.






